

McDonald's

New frogs

Scientists have recently found a new species of pink and yellow frog with sharp spikes. These thorny tree frogs live high up in remote mountains in Vietnam. The high peaks of central Vietnam perhaps do not seem the most logical place to go hunting for amphibians: the terrain is steep and rocky, and there is almost no water where the frogs can live. However, Australian biologist Jodi Rowley and her team found that these frogs live in holes in trees filled with water. They didn't find many tree holes but they found a frog in nearly every one!
